



'Thursday Twilight Navigation Handicap Events

Competition Rules – (at 22/05/2018)

The 'Thursday Twilight Navigation' open competition runs in conjunction with the rules of [Southport Yacht Clubs Predicted Nav Events Handbook \(August 2017\)](#), with the following main exceptions:

- An SYC Member of any category (not including Social) may enter in an event with a vessel of any size / type . At committee's discretion a vessel deemed unsuitable may be refused entry to an event.
- All events are run as GPS Events.
- The twilight navigation events are separate from any other series or club championship offered by SYC and separate entry fees apply for these events.
- The 'Handicap Events' are run as handicap events using a handicap system determined by the Power Boat Committee which may vary from the Southport Yacht Clubs Predicted Nav Events Handbook (August 2017). Awards are based on handicap scores only.
- Competing Vessels are to monitor VHF CH 72 where a vessel is fitted with such device.
- Vessels are not required to be on the SYC Yacht Register, or to display competition numbers however those competing SYC members whose boat is registered on the SYC Yacht register must display the SYC burgee while competing.
- Course issuing & instructions, start times, entry register, and other event information or special instructions are as advised by SYC web site, email, notice or otherwise either in advance of events or from time to time
