INVITATION

Southport Yacht Club extends a warm invitation to all owners, skippers and crews of all eligible boats to enter and compete in the 2017 Bartercard Sail Paradise Regatta to be sailed on Windward/Leeward, Triangle and Ocean Passage Courses on the waters off Main Beach and Surfers Paradise from the 8th to 12th January 2017.

ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority shall be Southport Yacht Club Inc. (SYC) located at 1 Macarthur Parade, Main Beach QLD 4217. Phone (07) 5537 7030. Fax (07) 5537 7131.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 (RRS)
- 1.2 the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia (YA),
- 1.3 the relevant One Design Class Rules (as applicable),
- 1.4 The IRC Rules 2013 Parts A, B and C shall apply.
- 1.5 Except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2 CHANGES TO THE RACING RULES OF SAILING

- 2.1 RRS 50.2 and 50.3: Fixed and retractable spinnaker poles and bowsprits will be permitted for the purpose of setting asymmetrical spinnakers.
- 2.2 Rule 49.1 shall not apply to Sports Boats if racing in compliance with their respective class rules and it is noted on the Sports Boats SMS certificate that the boat incorporates hiking devices.
- 2.3 RRS 78.1: Valid rating/class certificates must be included with the completed entry form.
- 2.4 The Race Committee may make measurement inspections at any time during the regatta. This alters RRS 78.3.

3 ADVERTISING

- 3.1 Advertising on a boat shall comply with the requirements of ISAF Regulation 20 (ISAF Advertising Code) for Category C.
- 3.2 The Organising Authority may reject an entry of a boat, which in its opinion is carrying advertising conflicting with that of the regatta sponsors. In any case of doubt, the Organising Authority should be consulted as soon as practicable.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to boats that meet the following entry requirements:
 - (a) All competitors must be a current member of their National Sailing Federation and have the appropriate documentation available for inspection at registration.
 - (b) Competitors may enter for one of the following Divisions:
 - 4.1a **Performance Handicap System (PHS) Rated Racing & Cruising monohull and multihull boats** that comply with Yachting Australia Special Regulations Part 1 Category 5.
 - 4.1a.1 Sub-Divisions may be made by the Race Committee based on boat numbers, ie Monohull Spinnakers, Monohull Non-Spinnakers, Multihull Division's etc.
 - 4.1b **4.1b.1 IRC monohull boats shall hold a current IRC measurement certificate** and must submit a copy with their entry.
 - 4.1b.2 Sub Divisions may be made based on numbers of IRC boats.
 - 4.1b.3 The maximum total crew weight in kilograms that may sail on board a boat shall not exceed the crew number printed on the boats IRC certificate multiplied by 85.
 - 4.1b.4 For the purpose of IRC Rules 2.1.1.5(d) and (e) this regatta is on consecutive days and the sails carried on board shall remain the same.

- 4.1c **Australian Measurement System (AMS) Rated Racing & Cruising monohull and multihull boats** that comply with Yachting Australia Special Regulations Part 1 Category 5.
4.1c.1 Sub-Divisions may be made by the Race Committee based on boat numbers, ie Monohull Spinnakers, Monohull Non-Spinnakers, Multihull Division's etc.
- 4.1d **Trailable Yachts** that comply with Part 1 Category 6 (SYC) up to 8m in length.
- 4.1e **Sports Boats** with a current SMS rating certificate that complies with Part 1 Category 6.
- 4.1f **International Etchells** that comply with Etchells Class rules.
- 4.2 One-Design Classes and sub-divisions may be made or divisions may be joined, subject to the number of entries received and at the sole discretion of the Race Committee.
- 4.3 The person-in-charge of a boat shall be a current financial member of a Club affiliated with Yachting Australia, and an affiliated member of Yachting Australia, and the boat shall be listed on the register of vessels of a Club affiliated with Yachting Australia.
- 4.4 All boats shall hold a current Public Liability and Third Party Insurance Policy to the value of not less than AUD\$10 Million, which includes coverage for racing in the Regatta.
- 4.5 For all One Design Classes, a boat shall not change specifications after the close of entries. Any change to the hull, spars, sails, foils, ballast, equipment or any other factor which may affect the performance of the boat may be made only with the express written consent of the Race Committee

5 FEES AND DOCUMENTATION TO BE LODGED

- 5.1 Race Fees for the 2017 Bartercard Sail Paradise Regatta shall be \$150 for all Divisions
- 5.2 Entries shall be lodged with the Organising Authority **no later than 1700 hours on Wednesday 4th January 2017**. Late entries may be accepted after this date at the discretion of the Organising Authority. Eligible boats shall enter via the Bartercard Sail Paradise online website located at www.sailparadise.com.au accompanied by the required Entry Fee and supplementary documentation, as applicable.
 - 5.2a All boats shall comply with their relevant Special Regulations.
 - 5.2b Crew Particulars, including Yachting Australia Numbers, are required at time of online Entry.
 - 5.2c Where the person-in-charge of a boat is under the age of eighteen (18) years, their Parent or Guardian shall complete & submit the Parent/Guardian Declaration Form at time of on-line entry.
 - 5.2d Class Measurement and Rating Certificates, as required
 - 5.2e For a boat entered in a One-Design Class, the document(s) specified as required by its One-Design Rules and Regulations.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available from the sailing office or online at www.sailparadise.com.au from 0900hrs Thursday 5th January 2017.

8 VENUE

8.1 The Regatta will be conducted from Southport Yacht Club (SYC) located at 1 Macarthur Parade, Main Beach, Qld 4217. Phone: (+61) 7 5591 3500 Fax: (+61) 7 5532 7507.

9 COURSES

9.1 The courses shall be Triangle, Windward/Leeward, Ocean Marks and Passage Course configurations, as described in the Sailing Instructions.

10 VESSEL IDENTIFICATION

10.1 All vessels will be issued bow numbers by the organising authority. Bow numbers are to be placed on the vessel according to the Sailing Instructions.

10.2 All vessels will be issued divisional flags by the organising authority. Flags shall be flown astern.

11 HANDICAPPING

11.1 **One Design Classes** with the lowest elapsed time (after application of scoring penalties if any) will be scored first.

11.2 **Sportsboat** results will be calculated using each boat's SMS rating.

11.3 **IRC** results will be calculated using each boat's TCC Handicap.

11.4 **AMS** results will be calculated using each boat's AMS rating.

11.5 **PHS** results will be calculated based on a Performance Handicap System (PHS) Time Correction Factor (TCF). The TCF that is determined and allocated by the Race Committee or its nominee will be

performance-based and will be expressed as four (4) decimal places applied as a multiplier to elapsed times. The TCF may be altered between races, and will not be subject to protest, redress or dispute (amends RRS 60.1 and 62.1(a)) A list of TCF ratings will be posted on the notice board prior to briefing.

12 SCORING

12.1 For each Division, the Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.

12.2 One race must be completed to constitute a series. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

13 ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

13.1 The Two-Turns penalty (RRS 44.1) is changed to a One Turn penalty except for infringements that occur within the *zone*.

14 BERTHING, LAUNCHING & HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

14.1 All boats competing are encouraged to berth or raft up along the beach at SYC Main Beach for the duration of the regatta as this is where the social events will be held. SYC offers limited FREE berthing and rafting space to competing yachts from 10am Saturday 7th January 2017 through to 10am Friday 13th January 2017. However, **BERTHING SPACE IS LIMITED** and we ask that you please arrange berthing allocations well in advance with the Marina Office: ph (07) 5591 3500. Rafting space for the Etchells, One Designs and the Trailables will be along the beach in front of the club.

15 PRIZES

15.1 The Bartercard Sail Paradise Trophy presentation will be staged asap after the last race on Thursday 12th January at Southport Yacht Club, Main Beach. This will include the presentation of the Bartercard Sail Paradise Perpetual Trophy.

15.2 Prizes will be awarded to First, Second and Third in each Division or Sub Division for the regatta. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

16 SKIPPERS BRIEFING

16.1 A compulsory skippers briefing will be held at Southport Yacht Club Main Beach at 0800 on each sailing day during the regatta.

17 SKIPPERS COCKTAIL PARTY

An exclusive Skippers Cocktail Party will be held for the Skipper +1 (husbands/wives/partners) for each Entry for IRC Monohull, Cat 5 & Cat 6 Monohulls & Multihulls at the Yacht Club on Saturday 7th January 2017 @ 1900hrs.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

FOR BARTERCARD SAIL PARADISE 2017

B.1 LAUNCHING

There are launching facilities at Main Beach as well as Hollywell. The Main Beach facility has a boat ramp and marina while the facility located at 1 Marina Crescent, Hollywell has a crane, boat ramp and boatyard for trailers. Hollywell is approximately 4 Nautical Miles to the North of the Southport Yacht Club Main Beach clubhouse and easily accessible by the channels of the Broadwater. Trailer Sailors are encouraged to leave their boats in the water overnight at Main Beach. No overnight berthing will be permitted on the marina at the Hollywell Sailing Squadron. There is no Mast Stepping Gantry available. Competitors are advised to bring their own A-frame or Gin Pole for stepping of masts, although equipment may be available to be borrowed from Gold Coast Etchells Fleet Members.

B.2 TRAILERS

Trailers may be kept on the grounds immediately adjacent to the SYC Hollywell Sailing Squadron by arrangement with the Sailing Office on Telephone (07) 5537 7030. Trailers may also be kept at the Eastern side of the Southport Yacht Club Main Beach car park by arrangement with the Marina Manager, on Telephone (07) 5591 3500. While all care is taken, no responsibility is assumed by Southport Yacht Club Inc for any property left on or around Club premises.

B.3 FACILITIES

Changing Rooms, Showers and Toilets are located at the Western Side of the Main Beach Clubhouse. Entry to the shower block requires an access card that also gives access to the Marina Security Doors. Access Cards are available from the Marina Office and require a security deposit, refundable upon return.

Pay-Phones are located next to the Shower Block gates and inside the Clubhouse directly opposite the Reception Desk. Facsimile services are available at the Reception Desk at standard rates.

The Bosun's Locker Chandlery is located at the western side of the compound and stocks most common boat parts. There are several sailmakers located in close proximity to the Club.

B.4 HOSPITALITY

The Clubhouse has a Licensed Bar, a Restaurant offering a quality range of food at affordable prices, and patio seating overlooking the Broadwater. In accordance with Queensland Liquor Licensing Regulations, all visitors will need to produce identification and sign in. This is only required once for each day you visit the Clubhouse.
