

Main Beach Clubhouse Dress Regulations

Southport Yacht Club welcomes all members and visitors but we do ask that you are suitably attired. Members and Visitors are required to observe correct dress in the clubhouse at all times.

Neat and tidy casual dress is permitted at all times.

Downstairs

- ◆ Clean and tidy Track suits and sportswear. (downstairs only).
- ◆ No T-shirts with objectionable language or designs
- ◆ No Football or stubbie shorts
- ◆ No Work clothes or overalls
- ◆ No Training apparel
- ◆ Shorts cannot be worn without shoes

After 6.30pm Downstairs

- ◆ No Boardshorts or swimwear

Upstairs at anytime

- ◆ Smart/casual wear must apply at all times.
- ◆ No shorts
- ◆ No Boardshorts or swimwear
- ◆ No thongs are permitted
- ◆ No Training apparel

Not permitted at anytime:

- ◆ T-shirts with objectionable language or designs
- ◆ Football or stubbie shorts
- ◆ Singlets, tank tops or shirts without sleeves
- ◆ Dirty or torn clothing

Hats are not to **be worn inside the club premises** other than on those special occasions deemed special circumstances/occasions by the Board of Directors.

Interpretation and alteration of these rules is at the discretion of club management.

Unacceptable Attire

Dirty, untidy or inappropriate clothing, singlets, torn jeans, hats, swim or beachwear, thongs or slippers. Please note that in the event of a dispute concerning dress standards, Management reserves the right to have the final decision.

Children

Southport Yacht Club welcomes families with children and whilst our staff will make you and your children most welcome, they are not baby sitters and expect that children will be well supervised at all times. Children must also wear shoes at all times.

Members

Please assist our door personnel by showing your Membership Card when entering the club.

Under 18 patrons are permitted in certain areas of the club, however, they must be in the company of an adult at all times.

Proof of Age and residential qualification is required.

Please remove your hat before entering the premises.

Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any person not confirming with the licensing or club regulations.
