

Rules of Dux

Welcome to the Southport Yacht Club Inc. (SYC) Dux Facility. We wish you an enjoyable visit, and request that you make yourself aware of the following conditions which apply to access and use Dux.

- Dux is for the use of Life, Gold, Country, Senior, Intermediate members and their guests*, Cadets over 16yrs and 18yrs of age may use Dux, however are not entitled to take guests (all other Cadets must be accompanied by an adult member). Members of Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron and their guests* are also welcome to use Dux.
 - * Limits of the number of guests may be applied at certain peak times of the year in the interest of maintaining fair and equal access for all members.
 - * A member wishing to invite 10 or more guests (including children) must apply to the Main Beach Club Administration for approval. Maximum number of visitors in any one group, on any one occasion, is 15 (this includes all members and family members).
- 2. All family and guests are to be under the supervision and in the company of the member at all times.
- 3. SYC members and Reciprocal Club members are required to show their current membership cards to the caretaker on arrival.
- 4. The only reciprocal club members permitted to use Dux are those members of Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron (full members).
- 5. Certain areas of Dux have been set aside for camping, games, cooking of food, etc. Please respect these areas and only undertake each activity in the designated areas.
- 6. From time to time the caretaker may, without notice, close off any area for rejuvenation or repair, and request an alternative site be used.
- 7. Due to the delicate nature of the ground cover in sandy areas, we request you do not cover grassed areas with ground sheets, tarpaulins, etc. without seeking approval from the caretaker.
- 8. No dogs, or other pets / animals, are permitted onshore at Dux as per the Council regulations at South Stradbroke Island where Dux is located.
- 9. When camping at Dux please keep noise to a minimum after 8.30pm to ensure comfort of all our members and their guests.
- 10. Permission for a group to use Dux does not constitute a booking, nor does it give any member or their guest's exclusive use of any of the facilities.
- 11. The caretakers are commissioned by the General Manager of the Club on behalf of the Board, to ensure compliance with the rules of Dux and have the right to remind members and their guests of their obligation to abide by these rules.
