NOTICE OF RACE

The Southport Yacht Club as Organising Authority, in association with the Australian Hansa Class Association (AHCA), extends an invitation to all Hansa Class sailors to participate in the 2021 Hansa Class Queensland Championships -

COVID-19 Note: Due to the current uncertainty surrounding public events, the format of the Event may change depending on Queensland Government Public Health Orders. Entries for the 2021 Hansa Class Queensland Championships may be capped to comply with mass gathering restrictions, which include competitors, support vessel personnel, race management and staff involved in the Championships.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2
- 1.3 The Racing Rules will be changed as follows:
- 1.3.1 Rule 41. Outside Assistance may be provided by support, safety and committee boats and will be limited to assistance with reefing, bailing and body repositioning if necessary. For vision impaired sailors, where electronic or verbal instructions are used to assist sailors, that assistance shall be limited to safety directions and assistance.
- 1.3.2 Rule 44.1 Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.3.3 Rule 61.1(a) The hail "Protest" is not required but should be made where possible.
- 1.3.4 Rule 63.3(a) A representative at a protest hearing need not have been on board at the time of the incident.
- 1.3.5 Any amendments to this Notice of Race will be published on the Southport Yacht Club Website.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 Competitors in the Queensland Hansa Class Championships are required to be current financial members of the Australian Hansa Class Association or an International Hansa Class Association. AHCA membership may be renewed at:

- 3.2 Applicants must be members of a Club affiliated to Australian Sailing or another World Sailing Member National Authority.
- 3.3 Entry for vision impaired sailors will be restricted to category B2 or B3 sailors in the single person divisions. Vision impaired sailors of any category may compete in the two person divisions with a sighted crew member.
- 3.4 The regatta is open to all Hansa 303 Wide. The Hansa 303S (Single) shall not compete.
- 3.5 The Hansa 303 Wide will be sailed by a single person only. To be eligible for the Servo prizes, the helm and all sheets must be controlled by servo electric equipment. Partial servo boats are deemed to be manual.
- 3.6 The minimum number of entries required for an open division is three (3) boats. For a servo division, no minimum number of entries is required but the servo boats shall sail within a valid open division.
- 3.7 Entries and supporting documentation shall be submitted by 10am Saturday 9 October

4. CHARTER BOATS

- 4.1 A number of boats will be available for charter. Details are available on the event website.
- 4.2 A \$300 damage deposit will be required. If no damage is incurred by the chartered boat, this deposit will be refunded. Any cost for any damage incurred will be paid from this deposit to the charterer.
- 4.3 Charter fees are as follow:

5.1 A competitor may enter a single division only. Entry Fees are in Australian Dollars (AUD) and will be:

- 6.2 Three races are scheduled for each class each day.
- 6.3 A maximum of 6 races are scheduled for each class. No warning signal shall be made after 1500 hours on Sunday 10 October.

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Boats may be inspected at any time during the regatta.
- 7.2 Sails must be marked in accordance with the current class rules and RRS Appendix G.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the Southport Yacht Club website on Thursday 7 October 2021 and will be available to competitors at registration.

9. RACE AREA

9.1 The race area for all Hansa Classes will be on the Gold Coast Broadwater as detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

10. THE COURSES

10.1 The courses shall be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 For all classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

13. SCORING

- 13.1 RRS Appendix A shall apply, except that when fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 13.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series in each division.

14. SAFETY

- 14.1 Whilst afloat or on marina pontoons or launching ramps, all competitors shall wear lifejackets.
- 14.2 Attention is drawn to RRS 1.2 and RRS 3.

15. BERTHING & HAULOUT RESTRICTIONS

15.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the Hollywell basin or in the rigging area. All Liberties and SKUD 18s shall remain in the water for the duration of the regatta.

16. SUPPORT BOATS

16.1 Coaches and support personnel that are intending to bring their own support vessels are required to provide their vessel details to the SYC Sailing Officer by Wednesday 6 October 2021 to arrange approval. 16.2 All coach/support boats must carry a working marine VHF radio and complaint safety equipment.

17. RADIO COMMUNICATION

17.1 Except with the prior permission of the race committee, a competing boat shall neither make radio or data transmissions while racing nor receive radio or data communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
