4.2 FEES

4.2.1 Regatta entry fee for the Australasian Championships (3 days of racing, 28 - 30 May 2022) is \$660. This fee will include entry to the Gold Coast Championships (two days of racing, 28 - 29 May 2022).

4.2.2 Regatta entry fee for the Gold Coast Championships (2 days of racing, 28 – 29 May 2022) is \$575. (An "Early Bird" entry fee of \$475.00 is available to entries received by 1700hrs on 24/04/2022).

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS CONTINUED

- 5.1 A maximum of nine (9) races will be conducted for the Australasian Championships and a maximum of six (6) races for the Gold Coast Championships.
- 5.2 No warning signal will be made after 1500 hours on the last scheduled day of racing of the regatta.
- 5.3 The race committee at its discretion may elect to sail more than the scheduled number of races on any day and as a result may amend the time of the warning signal for the first race of that day.
- 5.4 If the race committee decides to sail another race after completion of the day's scheduled race(s) this will be signaled by flying Code Flag "L" from the finish boat.
- *Refer to section 14 for alternate launching option.

6. REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT (DP)

- 6.4Five (5) stickers will be issued to each entrant for affixing to the sails to be used in this event. All sails must have a valid measurement stamp affixed and signed by a class measurer.
- 6.5 All registration formalities, including payment of all Class and event fees, crew weigh in and presentation of required certificates, must be completed by 0900 hours on Saturday 28th May 2022.
- 6.6 Boats competing in the Corinthian Division shall be required to sign a declaration in relation to the competitors' World Sailing Category status or show a print out of their World Sailing Classification, no later than the close of registration.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 Australasian Championships. Nine races are scheduled. Three (3) races are required to constitute a series.
- 11.1.2 When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This amends RRS A2.
- 11.1.3 If four or more races are completed, then a boat's worst result will be dropped from the total score.
- 11.2 Gold Coast Championships. Six races are scheduled. Two (2) races are required to constitute a series.
- 11.2.1 When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This amends RRS A2.
- 11.2.2 If four or more races are completed, then a boat's worst result will be dropped from the total score.
- 11.2.3 Additional PHS Scoring Results will be provided.
- 11.2.3.1 PHS results will be calculated based on a Performance Handicap System (PHS) Time Correction Factor (TCF). The TCF that is determined and allocated by the Race Committee, or its nominee will be performance-based and will be expressed as three (3) decimal places applied as a multiplier to elapsed times.
- 11.2.3.2 The TCF may be altered between races, and will not be subject to protest, redress or dispute (amends RRS 60.1 and 62.1(a)).
- 11.2.3.3 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2.3.4 If up to three races are completed, then all results will count. This amends RRS A2.
- 11.2.3.5 If four or more races are completed, then a boat's worst result will be dropped from the total score.

14. BOAT LAUNCH AND RETRIEVAL (DP)

After racing is completed on the Monday, boats will be required to sail back to their respected launch points for crane retrieval. Tow boats will be available if required to assist in returning to SYC Hollywell.

20 PRIZES

- 20.1 Australasian Championships and Gold Coast Championships.
- 20.1.1 Keeper trophies will be awarded to the first three place-getters overall.
- 20.1.2 Perpetual Trophies will be awarded to the overall winners
- 20.1.3 The Etchells Masters Division Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the Masters' division winner. (Masters means a helmsman of 60 years of age or older at midnight on 26 May 2022).
- 20.1.4 The Etchells Grand Masters Division Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the Grand Master's division winner.
- Grand Masters division total age not less than 165 years for a three person crew and 220 years for a four person crew.
- 20.1.5 The Etchells Corinthian Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the Corinthian division winner.
- 20.1.6 The Womens Trophy will be awarded to the first placed female helm.
- 20.1.7 The Fleet that is scored the most may be awarded a perpetual trophy.
- 20.1.8 The top First time skipper may be awarded a trophy.
- 20.2 Gold Coast Championships
- 20.2.1 The inaugural, Etchells Gold Coast Championship Perpetual Trophy for the overall winner
- 20.2.2 Additional PHS Prizes for the First, Second and Third PHS Overall.

- 20.3 Other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority, including daily prizes and random draws after each day's racing.
- 21.4 Prize Presentation Ceremony will be held at SYC Main Beach at approx. 1700hrs on Monday 30th May 2022.
- 20.4 Prize Presentation Ceremony for the Gold Coast Championships will be held at SYC Main Beach at approx. 1700hrs on Sunday 29th May 2022.
- 22.5 Prize Presentation Ceremony for the Australasians will be held at SYC Main Beach at approx. 1700hrs on Monday 30th May 2022.
