AMENDMENTS, ADDITIONS & DELETIONS

2. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority (OA) shall be Southport Yacht Club Inc. (SYC) located at 1 Marina Crescent, Hollywell QLD 4216. Phone (07) 5537 7030. Fax (07) 5537 7131, in conjunction with the Queensland Paper Tiger Catamaran Association (QPTCA) under the authority of Australian Sailing (AS).

- **3.3** The regatta is open to boats of the Paper Tiger Catamaran class and the current Paper Tiger Catamaran Class Rules apply.
- 3.4 ---- The current AS Yardsticks Catamarans (ASY) shall apply.
- 5.5 Eligibility for Youth is for persons-under 21 years of age as of 30th December 2022. under 18 years old and shall be under 18 years old for the entire duration of the regatta (i.e. born after 11th January 2004).
- 7.1 A maximum of 9 races are scheduled
- 7.6 Fri 6th January 2023 APTCA Annual General Meeting 1600hrs
- 8.1 Each boat shall show a valid measurement certificate at registration and, in addition, shall present their boat during the prescribed measurement period where the following measurement checks will be taken: boat weight, mast dimensions, and sail dimensions.

12. SCORING & HANDICAPPING

- 12.6. When eight to twelve races or more have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 12.7. When from thirteen to sixteen races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.
- 12.8. ASY & PHS Results will be scored.
- 12.9. A boats PHS rating for its 1st race will be its ASY and then its PHS may be adjusted after each race.
- **15 a.** Championship placings for 1st, 2nd & 3rd the first top 10 placings.
 - c. B Grade Champion 1st, 2nd and 3rd
 - d. C Grade Champion 1st, 2nd and 3rd
 - -e. Championship placings for 1st, 2nd & 3rd on PHS Results
 - f. 1st rookie.
 - g. 1st female.
 - h. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.
