

The first ever Para Sailing International Championships for athletes with an intellectual impairment is taking place at Southport Yacht Club, Hollywell on Queensland's Gold Coast from 5-11 November 2022.

The International Championship is open to eligible sailors who are listed on the Virtus Master List, prior to competing in the Hansa 303 class event. Below is a quick reference for Australian athletes on how to enter the International Championship.

Australian entrants have a choice of entering as an:

- Australian Team Member, participating in the Virtus Oceania Asia Games 2022 and the Para Sailing International Championships; or
- o Independent Sailor, competing in the Para Sailing International Championships.
