

## **Cruise Report**

### **BMS 6 Day Labour Day Cruise – 5<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> of May 2024**

This cruise started at the RQYS Canaipa facility with 10 boats attending, meeting on shore for a pleasant get together with drinks and BBQ. The weather throughout the cruise was a bit average, with mostly overcast, windy and rainy conditions.

The cruise itinerary included two days in Moreton Bay, however the weather was not suitable to provide pleasant anchorages, which is not unusual for Moreton Bay.
