1. INVITATION

Southport Yacht Club extends a warm invitation to all owners, skippers and crews of all eligible boats to enter and compete in the 2022 Da\$h for Ca\$h to be sailed on the Gold Coast Broadwater on Sunday 15th September 2024.

2. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority will be Southport Yacht Club Inc. (SYC) located at the Hollywell Sailing Squadron located at 1 Marina Crescent, Hollywell, Qld 4216, Phone (+61) (07) 5537 7030

3. RULES

- 3.1 The Regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 3.2 The Special Regulations (SR) of Australian Sailing (AS): Part 2 shall apply for Off the Beach Dinghies.
- 3.3 As applicable, the relevant One Design Class Rules.
- 3.4 RRS Appendix T Arbitration will apply.
- 3.5 The International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (COLREGS) 1972 shall apply at all times. RRS will only apply between those boats that are participating in the event, for the duration of the event. Should interaction occur with non-participating boats, then COLREGS shall apply to all boats and shall over-ride all other rules.

4. ELIGIBITY & ENTRY

- 4.1 Dash for Cash is open to:
 - 4.1.1 Trailable & Cruising Monohull and Multihull boats that comply with Australian Sailing 2021-2024 Special Regulations Part 1 for Racing Boats, Safety Category 7.
 - 4.1.2 Off the Beach Catamarans must comply with Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 for Off-The-Beach Boats.
 - 4.1.3 Off the Beach Dinghies that comply with Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 for Off-The-Beach Boats.
- 4.2 A minimum of Five (5) class entries are required to constitute a division.
- 4.3 The Club may make more divisions if necessary
- 4.4 person-in-charge of a boat shall be a current financial member of a Club affiliated with Australian Sailing, and an affiliated member of Australian Sailing, and the boat shall be listed on the register of vessels of a Club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
- 4.5 A boat shall not change specifications after the close of entries. Any change to the hull, spars, sails, foils, appendages, ballast, equipment or any other factor which may affect the performance of the boat may be made only with the express written consent of the Race Committee.





4.6 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the Race Committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

5. FEES

- 5.1. The required early bird entry fee paid before midnight on Friday 6^{th} September will be \$45.00
 - 5.1.1 The required entry fee paid between the 7th September and the 10th September will be \$90.00.
 - 5.1.2 Entries will close at 4pm on the 10th September.
- 5.2 Eligible boats shall enter via the Southport Yacht Club Website http://www.southportyachtclub.com.au/sailing/special-sailing-events-2/ accompanied by the required Entry Fee.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available from the SYC Hollywell Sailing Office and online on the SYC website after 1600hrs Friday 13th September 2024.

7. VENUE & RACING AREA

2024 Da\$h for Ca\$h will be conducted from Southport Yacht Club Hollywell, 1 Marina Crescent Hollywell. The racing area shall be the Broadwater, between the Gold Coast Seaway and the entrance to the Coomera River.





8. COURSES

The course shall be a passage type course as described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. HANDICAPS

Handicaps and results will be based on AS Yardstick, CBH or PHS or assigned by the organising authority where necessary.

11. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

The Two-Turns penalty (RRS 44.1) is changed to a One Turn penalty except for infringements that occur within the zone.

12. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A..

13. PRIZES

- 13.1 Members Cash Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each Division
- 13.2 Members Cash Prizes will be awarded for Line Honours in each Division.

14. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participation in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for said event in which the competitor participated and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the series.

16. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10M (AUD) per event or the equivalent.
