

## Cutty Sark Trophy – TRADITIONAL EVENT (NO GPS)

Date:	Saturday, 12 <sup>th</sup> October 2024
Event type:	The Event will be run as a <b>TRADITIONAL event</b> (no GPS allowed) as per the SYC Navigation Rally handbook and Competition Rules
Course:	The course on Pisces is CK-E-2. Course is also published on SYC website (under powerboats)
Event info:	The Course chart, Instructions (ie. Turn Point co-ordinates) and Start Times will be published to the SYC website. First (and slowest) boat away is from 2:30pm.
Tack Trackers:	Use the same tracker you used for the trip up to Dux. That tracker will be re-issued to you after it has been downloaded after the Powerboat Committee Trophy.

Note: Tack Trackers must NOT be ON if crossing the start line whilst progressing to the start. Allow a minimum of 15 minutes before your start time to allow your trackers to obtain a GPS fix. Please ensure you ACTIVATE BOTH tracker units as per the instructions on each unit – the Tack Trackers may be different models. Deliver your Tack Trackers to the SYC RIB immediately after finishing the event. Do not turn them off!

Entry:	You are automatically entered into this event if you have a 'season entry' or if you have entered the Powerboat Committee Trophy as a 'casual entry'. Your nominated speed will be the same as your entry into the Powerboat Committee Trophy event. Your participation in this event is entirely optional.
To Enter:	Enter via the 'link to enter' on SYC website (menu/on water/powerboats/navigation/next event). Enter the Powerboat Committee Trophy event to also receive your entry into the Cutty Sark Trophy.
Venue:	This is an 'on water' event only. No presentation held on the day of the event.
	Presentation of prizes will occur at the next SYC Navigation rally event.
Comms:	Please ensure you have your VHF radio on Channel 72
Safety:	Waiting vessels please keep clear 400m before the Start
