Thursday 3 rd	9:00 12:30	Up anchor and move 3.5NM to Alexander Clark Park ETA 9:35. HW at 11:17 of 2.13 Meet ashore for BYO Drinks and wood fired BBQ.
Friday 4 th	12:00	Up anchor and move 11.5NM to Redbill Island ETA 13:55 HW at 10:56 of 2.08m. Relax on boats.
Saturday 5 th	11:00 16:30	Up anchor and move 12.8NM to Dux ETA 12:49. HW at Logan Mouth at 11:28 of 2.1m. Meet ashore for BYO Drinks and BBQ at Dux.
Sunday 6 th	12:00	Meet ashore for lunch BYO Drinks and BBQ. BMS Random Draw for Club Cash & Precision Marine Wine Draw.
Monday 7 th		Vessels return to their home ports at their leisure or stay for a lunch at Tipplers. NB 7 th October is the Kings Birthday Public Holiday
