Sat 19 Oct		Cruisers make their way to Deep Hole and either anchor or circle until departure time. Log on to VMR Southport if you wish.	
	08:00 QLD	Depart Deep Hole and proceed in convoy 1.9 NM to exit the Seaway and head for a point outside Tweed Heads (approx. 15.7NM or 1h 57m at 8 knots). HW Tweed Heads 10:17. Enter the Tweed River at approx. 11:15 NSW and proceed 2.5NM up the river and anchor at Cave Point. ETA 11:40 NSW. Log off from VMR Tweed Heads.	
	12:30 NSW	Meet for lunch at the Sheoak Shack Gallery Cafe.	
Sun 20 Oct	10:30 18:30	Walk to Fingal Head lighthouse. Up anchor and proceed 3.8NM to Stotts Island* (HW@ 13:14) continue upstream 5.3NM to Tumbulgum opposite the mouth of the Rous River. ETA 13:30. HW @ 13:41. *Beware the shallows before and after Stotts Island. Anyone wishes could do a dinghy safari up the Rous River and Mayal Creek, a 12NM circuit via Murwillumbah. Note: The Alexander Toohill Bridge has a clearance of 7.50 m MHWS. Meet for dinner at the Tumbulgum Tavern.	
Mon 21 Oct	10:00	Up anchor and proceed 3.1NM to Condong, anchor near the boat ramp.	
		Note: The Condong Bridge has a clearance of 4.4 m MHWS.	
		Meet ashore for BYO drinks and nibbles.	
Tue 22 Oct	10:00	Dinghy or move boat to 2.0NM to Murwillumbah.	
22 000		Explore the arts and crafts stores. The museum on Queensland Street is well worth a visit.	
	12:30	Meet for lunch at the Riverview Hotel.	
Wed 23 Oct	09:30	Up anchor and proceed 5.1NM down river to Tumbulgum. LW @ 10:37. Meet ashore and walk to Husk Distillery (1152 Dulguigan Road), for a tour of the distillery if you wish. Wed-Sun \$40-55 pp. Eating options: Husk Distillery, Tumbulgum Tavern, House of Gabriel (Book ahead) or the Bakery.	
	16:00	Up anchor and proceed 2.3NM to Stott's Island (Shallows) HW Stotts Island @ 16:05 and continue on 4.5NM to Chinderah. Anchor between the two green lateral marks. ETA 17:10. HW Chinderah @ 15:35.	
	19:00	Meet for dinner at the Chinderah Tavern and a member's random number drawer.	
Thur 24 Oct	12:00 NSW	Log on to Marine Rescue Point Danger if you wish. Make your way 4.8NM to Tweed Heads River exit and north towards the Gold Coast Seaway. ETA Seaway entrance 14:25 QLD (approx. 15.7NM or 2h 14m at 7 knots) Note: HW at Tweed Entrance will be at 15:04 NSW Note: HW at The Seaway will be at 14:03 QLD. DO NOT forget to log off with VMR Southport on return to Gold Coast. Vessels return to their home ports.

- Monitor VHF Ch 72 at 8:10 and 15:10 for updates.
- The times shown on the run sheet are NSW times and will apply from when we enter to when we exit the Tweed River.
- NB The Queensland State elections will be held on 26 October so vote early in case we get delayed at the Tweed or if you want to proceed to Dux after the cruise.
