Mon 18	7:30	Up anchor and proceed in convoy 19.9NM via Rainbow Channel to Kooringal. ETA 10:50. H.W. Kooringal 10:49 of 2.29m.
	12:00	Meet ashore for lunch at the Gutter Bar.
		Note: To avoid stranding, tie dinghies together in groups and move them out every 20-30 minutes during lunch. Tide dropping at a rate 0.24m per hour.
Tue 19	9:00	Optional dinghy safari to circumnavigate Crab Island and enjoy the vast array of sea life including stingrays, turtles, shovel nosed sharks and maybe a dugong or two. H.W. Kooringal 11:28 of 2.21m.
	16:30	Meet ashore on beach for BYO drinks and nibbles. LW18:24.
Wed 20	10:30	Depart Days Gutter via the Rainbow Channel route and cruise 22.6 NM to Dux anchorage for an overnight stay. H.W. Kooringal 12:16 of 2.10m. H.W. Canaipa Pt 13:13 of 2.52m. ETA Canaipa Pt 14:20, ETA Dux 15:10. Note: Some may wish to travel via main channel due to tide levels.
	17:30	Meet ashore for BBQ dinner, drinks and nibbles
Thur 21	12:00	Relax at Dux Meet ashore for lunch at Tipplers if you wish
	16:30	Meet ashore for BYO Drinks and BBQ at Dux. BMS Random Draw for Club Cash & Precision Marine Wine Draw.
