Cruise Report

SYC 19 Day Clarence River Cruise

19th October to 6th November 2025

RQYS originally proposed a 12-day Grafton cruise back in July and in doing so extended an invitation to SYC members to participate. An initial expression of interest was received from 12 SYC members but as the departure date approached and due to other commitments, only eight SYC boats actually participated.

On 8th October, RQYS advised that they would not be conducting the cruise as all of their participants had pulled out. So, it became an SYC cruise that loosely followed the original proposed itinerary.

This cruise was quite different to the usual SYC cruises as it involved 95nm of ocean passage each way and hence required careful voyage planning and consideration of the weather along the way as well as the tides at the various river bars. Once on the Clarence River, it was approximately 35nm up river to Grafton with many suitable stops along the way, including Iluka, Yamba, Harwood, Maclean, Lawrence, Brushgrove, and Ulmarra.

As indicated in the following more detailed itinerary, cruisers were able to organise themselves into smaller groups for the ocean passages and also as they moved up and down the Clarence River whilst occasionally crossing paths and enjoying each other's company from time to time.

Some boats came home earlier than others due to personal commitments whilst the remaining boats stayed on to enjoy the last few days of the Jacaranda Festival at Grafton.

Overall, all boats returned home safely and those who participated have mentioned how they thoroughly enjoyed the cruise and would do it again if/when the opportunity arises.

Day 1 – Sunday 19th October.

Vessels registered for the cruise were preparing for departure with some positioning near the Gold Coast Seaway ready for an early morning departure the next day.

Day 2 – Monday 20th October.

Five vessels departed the Gold Coast Seaway around first light for the trip to Yamba – *Bene, Fine Alley, Forty Something II, Honu and Lucinda. August Moon* cruised from the Gold Coast Seaway to the Tweed to overnight and to catch up with friends. All boats reportedly had good weather for the cruise.

Day 3 – Tuesday 21st October.

Harbor-Nating cruised down from the GC Seaway to Iluka and August Moon cruised down from the Tweed River to Iluka.
